Code of Conduct for meetings

Basic rules of respect are common knowledge. Please use common sense and best judgement.

- Treat all participants with kindness and respect
- Value a diversity of views and opinions
- Critique ideas, rather than individuals
- Respect the process for meeting participation
- Remain respectful and courteous to all in attendance (whether attendance is in-person or virtual)
- Refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior and speech directed toward others
- Refrain from disruptive or disrespectful conduct during others
 presentations
- Refrain from using language or gestures that are lewd or obscene
- Anger, rudeness, ridicule, impatience and lack of respect for others and personal attacks are not acceptable behavior.
- The board chair is responsible for maintaining order.
 Failure to abide by these conduct codes may result in the forfeiture of the speaker's right to speak.
